



ALARA LEVEL II: NOTIFICATION

Monitored Radiation Workers are notified when their exposures exceeds the ALARA Level II Criteria of 375 mRem per Quarter or 1500 mRem per Year.

Your Dose is above our Level II limit and indicates a need to review work procedures for possible reduction of exposure. Apply the basic rules of time, distance and shielding to keep your exposure as low as possible.

We routinely investigate ALARA Level Two exposures. Radiation Workers are required to complete the applicable questions listed on the below questionnaire. Please reply as quickly as possible so that we can evaluate any factors affecting your exposure.
